



## Blackboard and Copyright



**Do....**create stable links to e-journal articles to add to your reading lists

**Don't....**upload PDFs from e-journals to Blackboard as this breaks the terms of the licences

**Do....**request any scanned book chapters or journal articles from the Library in plenty of time for your module

**Don't....**scan any copyrighted materials yourself for use in Blackboard

**Do....**add e-book links from the library catalogue to your module

**Don't....**copy and paste or download material from the Internet for use on Blackboard

**Do....**use Aston's e-resources collection to search for copyright free images, music and video

**Don't....**use images, music or video on Blackboard without thinking copyright

**Do....**ask for advice if you are not sure about the copyright status of any item

**Don't....**think copyright doesn't apply to you as it's for educational use
